

HOW FIELD & FLOWER FOR SCHOOLS WORKS

Is ordering easy?

Ordering is hassle free, you can order on our website just like any other field&flower member, buying a regular box or one-offs boxes when you need them. All you need to do is use your special school promotion code on your first order so we know to allocate this and any future purchases you make to your school's fundraising pot. The minimum order value is £20.

Do I have to have a subscription to raise money for my school?

No, any orders will add to the fundraising pot.

I already have a field&flower account, can I still earn money for my school?

Definitely! Just send an email to Charlotte (our school scheme coordinator) schools@fieldandflower.co.uk or give her a ring on 0203 735 8008 and she will add your school's code to your account. All future orders you place will count towards the scheme.

Do I collect my box from school or are they delivered to my home?

All boxes can be delivered to your home, your work or anywhere else you'd like them sent. This can be changed from order to order to suit you. Just don't forget to confirm where you want the box to be delivered!

Which size subscription box would suit my family?

We have a range of boxes designed for different sized families and households. As a guide our boxes are based on a family eating 3-4 meat based meals a week.

Weekly Box: 4 people weekly, or 2 fortnightly.
Small Box: 1-3 people
Medium Box: 2-4 people
Large Box: 4-6 people

I'm not sure what to make with the items I've ordered.

We have lots of lovely recipes on our website and Alice our in-house chef is always on hand with advice and recipe ideas. Just use our 'Ask Alice' feature for advice.

What happens if I'm going on holiday?

Do I have to have the same thing every time?

With our regular subscription boxes you can change the contents of each box you receive. We have over 150 products available to choose from and we encourage you to try new cuts in each box. We also have seasonal items on special offer every month. Just remember to hit the 'confirm' button on the top left so that it can be processed with your amendments.

This is more expensive than my normal meat shop, why should I buy it?

It is true that unfortunately there are some supermarket prices we cannot match without cutting corners. Our meat is all free range, grass fed, dry aged and our farmers are paid a fair price. We believe that buying grass fed is a worthwhile investment, please click here for some more information about the nutritional, environmental and welfare benefits. What time will my box be delivered?

Unfortunately, at the moment we aren't able to specify an exact time window until the day of your delivery. DPD will send you a text or email on the morning of delivery to let you know a 1-hour time slot for delivery. Delivery is guaranteed to arrive by 7pm on your chosen day.

Can I recycle my box?

All of our boxes and ice packs are 100% recyclable so you can dispose of them with your usual recycling.
